Performance Competition – General Information

To recognise members' efforts in promoting the breed by entering competitions, the Council will run the performance competition for ridden and in hand Irish horses.

Publicity will be given in our newsletter and on Facebook.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **Please note** the revamped conditions, points and prizes for this year.
- The horse (filly, colt, mare. Stallion or gelding) must be registered with IDHS (NZ).
- The owner/competitor must be a financial member of the IDHS (NZ).
- The competition shall run from the **1 August to the 31 July** the following year (placings can only be used in one performance competition entry).
- All "Ridden Competition" horses must only gain points from competitions under saddle.
- Competition scores can be backdated for late entries.
- Horses sold during the year may have their scores transferred to the new owner on application of the Secretary and provided the new owner is, or becomes a member of the IDHS (NZ).
- Entries must be made on the official score sheet and be accompanied by the \$10 entry fee.
- **Score sheets must be returned to the performance co-ordinator no later than the 31 August each year. Results will be announced by 30 September.**
- The Council reserves the right to delete any competition which it considers ineligible for this competition and to check results with any shows/events it considers necessary.
- Trophies must be returned by the 31 July.
- **AN HONESTY SYSTEM WILL OPERATE.**

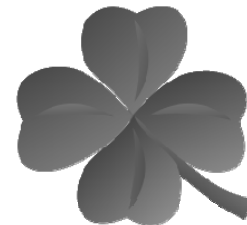
IN HAND COMPETITION (for horses 3 years and under)

Eligible Classes

Any in hand class will be eligible, eg those at A&P Shows, Breed shows, Pony Club competitions. (Turnout and handler classes are excluded)

Points

Supreme Champion	10 points
Champion	6 points
Reserve Champion	4 points
1 st	6 points
2 nd	5 points
3 rd	4 points
4 th	3 points
5 th	2 points
6 th	1 point



Any points scored at Horse of the Year or a Royal show will be doubled

(for horses 3 years and over)



Eligible Classes – any ridden classes run by any entity proved they are for OPEN competition. I.e. A&P Show, ESNZ, Open Pony Club or other event etc
