### Performance Competition – General Information

To recognise members' efforts in promoting the breed by entering competitions, the Council will run the performance competition for ridden and in hand Irish horses.

Publicity will be given in our newsletter and on Facebook.



#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **NEW SECTION – Inhand Adult Horse 4yrs and over**
- The horse (filly, colt, mare. Stallion or gelding) must be registered with IDHS (NZ).
- The owner/competitor must be a financial member of the IDHS (NZ).
- The competition shall run from the **1 August 2023 to the 31 July 2024** (placings can only be used in one performance competition entry).
- “Ridden Competition” is now for Ridden horses 4yrs of age and over only.
- Competition scores can be backdated for late entries.
- Horses sold during the year may have their scores transferred to the new owner on application to the Secretary and provided the new owner is, or becomes a member of the IDHS (NZ).
- Entries must be made on the official score sheet and the \$25 entry fee per section paid by **31 Aug.** please do separate form for inhand and ridden if doing both with same horse.
- **Score sheets must be returned to the performance co-ordinator no later than the 31 August each year. Results will be announced by 7th September and prizes posted ASAP.**
- The Council reserves the right to delete any competition which it considers ineligible for this competition and to check results with any shows/events it considers necessary.
- Trophies must be engraved by the Winners & returned by 31<sup>st</sup> July to 82 Waiareka Valley Rd, RD17C Oamaru 9491.

# IN HAND YOUNGSTOCK

(for horses 3 years and under) Eligible Classes



Any in hand class will be eligible, eg those at A&P Shows, Breed shows, Pony Club competitions. (Turnout and handler classes are excluded)

# INHAND ADULT

(for horses 4yrs and over) Eligible classes

Any in hand class will be eligible, eg those at A&P Shows, Breed shows, Pony Club competitions. (Turnout and handler classes are excluded)

1 <sup>st</sup>	6 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	5 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	3 points

6 <sup>th</sup>	1 point



Any points scored at Horse of the Year or a Royal show will be doubled



## RIDDEN COMPETITION

(for horses 4 years and over)

**Eligible Classes** – any ridden/inhand classes run by any entity proved they are for OPEN competition. I.e. A&P Show, ESNZ, Open Pony Club or other event etc

**Eventing Dressage will be done on percentage points with same scoring as Dressage.**

### **Bonus Points –**

- Versatility – excelling in two or more fields above throughout year, each event to be counted once for the year – 10 points (for each type)
- Supreme Champion 15 pts      Champion 6 pts      Reserve Champion 4 pts
- Competing for National or Regional Team 20 points
- Any points scored at Horse of the Year, a Royal Show or a National event will be doubled.
